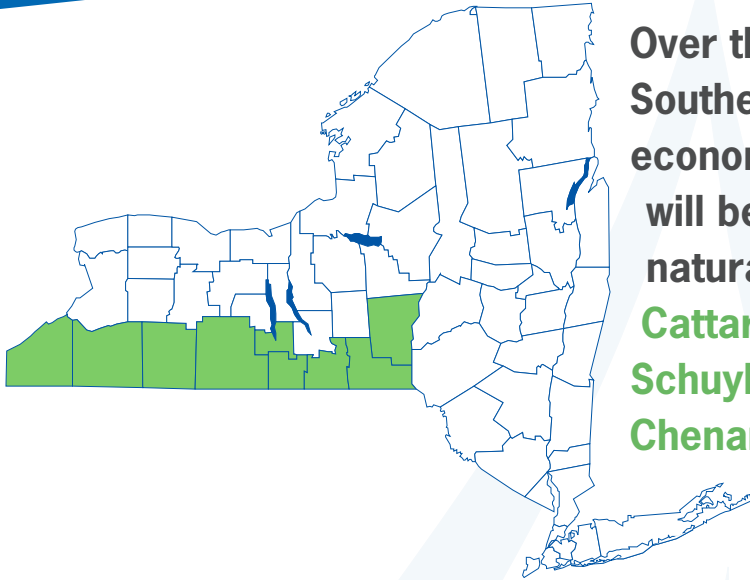


Safe Natural Gas Development is the Solution to New York's Stagnant Economy
