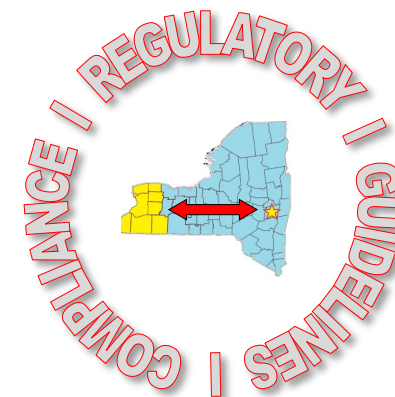

1:00 pm: NYS DEC, Division of Mineral Resources, Catherine Dickert, Director & Kyle Martindale, Mineral Resources Specialist 3. **“State Contracted Orphan Well Plugging”. Catherine & Kyle will present a summary of orphan well plugging projects initiated under state contracts this year. They’ll also cover some important changes to the contracting process that were recently implemented. These changes were meant to streamline the contracting process and result in more well plugging opportunities becoming available for companies to bid on. Some of the common pitfalls that our contractors have struggled with will also be covered in this talk. These include the need to obtain wetland permits for some projects, the difficulties of obtaining adequate insurance for these jobs, and dealing with stormwater pollution prevention requirements.**

1:30 pm: NYS DEC, Division of Air Resources, Ona Papageorgiou, P.E., Environmental Engineer II & Tom Wickerham, Environmental Program Specialist II. **“Air Focused Oil & Natural Gas Regulation Update”. Oil and natural gas sector news continues from the federal level to the State of New York. While regulation for existing sources may be uncertain at the federal level, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation still intends to move forward with a regulation proposal. Tom & Ona will provide the regulatory backdrop for oil and natural gas sources with discussion on what exists now and followed up with the status of the proposed New York oil and natural gas regulation.**
