**From the South:** Follow Rt. 219 North through Bradford, PA and Salamanca, then North 10 miles to Holiday Valley on 219.

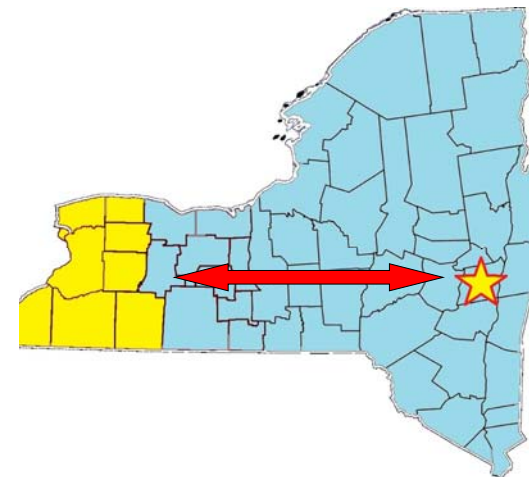

**12:00 pm:** Lunch & Networking

**1:00: NYS DEC, Division of Mineral Resources, Catherine Dickert, Director. "Division of Mineral Resources 2017: In Review"**. Catherine will give an overview and summary of the oil and gas permitting activity and their regulatory actions for 2017. She will also discuss well drilling, well plugging and common issues discovered during well inspections. She will provide an update on their revisions to the electronic permitting and reporting webpages and resources.

**1:30: NYS DEC, Division of Environmental Remediation, Andrea Skalski, P.E., Environmental Engineer 2. "Petroleum Bulk Storage Regulations for above ground tanks in New York State"**. Environmental, New Petroleum Bulk Storage Regulations went into effect in New York State in October 2015. This presentation will summarize the new requirements as they specifically apply to above ground storage tanks. Registration requirements, recordkeeping, operating requirements and tank installation and closure will be covered.

**2:00: NYS DEC, Division of Air Resources, Ona Papageorgiou, P.E., Environmental Engineer II & Tom Wickerham, Environmental Program Specialist II. "Air Focused Oil & Natural Gas Regulation Update"**. The oil and natural gas sector is rapidly changing and frequently in the spotlight as the general public becomes more aware and concerned about methane and other air emissions. Studies indicate that significant amounts of methane and other air pollutants are emitted from this sector through process activity and leaks. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has acted on these studies by developing regulations for this source of emissions. Ona & Tom will demonstrate how air emissions are estimated and how those estimates lead to regulation. They will also present a summary of where oil and natural gas regulations stand now.

**3:00: NYS DEC, Division of Water, Melanie Stein, E.I.T., Assistant Environmental Engineer, Region 9. "NYSDEC Division of Water Regulatory Issues"**. Melanie will discuss performing facility inspections for compliance with SPDES regulations and the Environmental Conservation Law. She will also discuss the SPDES permit initiative; terminating permits that are no longer needed (due to alternative brine handling methods or ceased production), modifying permits to include current water quality limits and potential difficulty in meeting those limits.

**3:30: NYS Department of Public Service (PSC), Kevin Speicher, Chief of the Pipeline Safety Section.** Kevin will share their expectations regarding operator audits, inspections, pipeline maintenance, odorization and reporting.

**4:00:** Interactive discussion with regulators

**4:30-5:30: "Beer & Bull" Reception;** Enjoy local craft beers, wine & light snacks while networking with industry professionals in an informal setting.
